### **Geauga Transit provides free rides to vote in general election**

*Geauga Transit Vote & Ride program allows Geauga County residents free public transportation to vote early or at polls on Election Day*

Geauga County, OH - Geauga County residents can take the local regional transit service, [Geauga Transit](http://www.geaugatransit.com), for free to their polling location for the general election on November 4.

Free rides are also available for early voting at the Geauga County Board of Elections, located at 12611 Ravenwood Drive, Suite 004, in Chardon, beginning October 7 through November 2.

Polling locations in Geauga County are open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on November 4. There is no in-person voting at the Board of Elections on Election Day.

Geauga Transit provides door-to-door transit service throughout Geauga County. The Vote & Ride program provides rides to early voting or polling locations at no charge and require a reservation. Reservations can be made as early as one week prior to your trip and as late as the same day. It is recommended to call as early as possible as reservations are made on a first call, first-serve basis. To schedule a reservation, call Geauga Transit Dispatch at 440-754-5555.
